Artists pay \$10/mo. space fee with the full amount, \$90, due April 1st

Please mark one of the following:

\_\_\_\_\_ All Gallery Artists who do not work in the Gallery, the Augusta Art Guild will receive 30% commission from all sales of your work.

\_\_\_\_\_ For Gallery Artists who agree to work (2) 5 hour shifts per month the Augusta Art Guild will receive 15% commission from all sales of your work.

- **\*Important Note\*** The money from all sales - cash / check / credit card - must first be maintained and processed by the Augusta Art Guild. After the appropriate sales tax and commission have been deducted, a check will be sent to the Artist within 30 days.
- The Augusta Art Guild will add 6% sales tax to the sale price which will be paid to the State of KY.
- The number of pieces per Artist may be limited depending on the size and available space.
- Any new work that is of a different style or medium than the juried work must be reviewed before being shown in the gallery.
- The Augusta Art Guild will do everything within its power to ensure the security of the Artist(s) work within the gallery. However, the Augusta Art Guild is not liable for any damage, loss, or theft.
