Entry Deadline: *February 16, 2026*

For twenty-five years, the Augusta Art Guild has sponsored a poster contest to promote “Art in the Garden,” our juried art show that always takes place on the first Saturday of June. In the past, this poster contest was open to Guild members only. *Now the Augusta Art Guild is inviting submissions from any artist.* Guild members will vote and the winning artist will be awarded a **PRIZE of \$200!** And, of course, the winning entry will be prominently featured on this year’s poster.

There are some ground rules regarding submissions. *Please review them carefully as entries that do not follow these guidelines are subject to disqualification.*

GUIDELINES

- Work must be of the artist’s original concept and own creation. No copyright infringement is permitted.
- Do NOT add text with information about Art in the Garden. ***All copy will be added later when the winning art goes to the printer.***
- Size: All entries must be a vertical orientation, **11” wide x 12” tall** (or a ratio of)
- Media: Any media may be used (e.g. pastels, oils, acrylic, photos, mixed media, and/or electronic media).
- Only one (1) submission will be accepted per artist.
- Entries may be submitted digitally as high res files via email to ***AugustaArtintheGarden@gmail.com.***
- Entries may be also delivered in-person to the Augusta Art Guild, 116 Main St., Augusta, KY by Monday, February 16th. Call Leah at 513-289-9800 in advance to schedule drop-off (Guild gallery is closed during winter months).
- All submissions must have contact information attached (e.g. artist’s name/phone/email)

The Augusta Art Guild is not liable for any artwork that is lost, damaged or stolen and will make every effort to return any submissions. It is the artists’ responsibility to make arrangements to pick up their submission before April 1st.
